# Reduce your speed. Keep our village safe.



This week is National Road Safety Week

Speeding in Marton-cum-Grafton is now a big issue with many drivers treating our roads like racetracks.

There have been a number of concerns voiced by **village** residents and we would ask that you make an effort to watch your speed carefully when driving through **the village** (or any other built up area). The fastest speed you should be driving is 30 mph but ideally we'd like to see **village** traffic at 20 mph.

A number of the roads in **Marton-cum-Grafton** don't have pavements or footpaths and this combined with fast vehicles is an accident waiting to happen. **The village** welcomes many walkers, cyclists and horse riders along with children going to and from school. Their safety is paramount.
